Mora grows high up in the mountains, in
regions where the guerrilla used to hide out.
Our Mora is sourced from Roncesvalles, in the
mountains of Tolima, first place in Colombia
to receive a public apology from FARC.

Mora sales are backing 'Dew & Drip' projects,
reducing watering costs and protecting crops
through 2 dry seasons a year. For the first pilot,
a hectare of drip irrigation for lulo was installed
in the Territory of Learning, Belén, see video:

A Dew Collector saves >50% of watering costs
and lasts for 9 Years, then can be recycled.

Peace

In 2016 a peace agreement was signed,
which ended 52 years of conflict between
the Colombian Government & Guerrilla.

In 2017, 7,000 guerrillas - formerly financed by
the drug trade - demobilised to Reintegration
Camps. This has created a historic chance
to fill the void with alternative crops.

Our supply chain is directly sowing in post-
conflict areas. Our friends in Territory of
Learning are positioned to distribute the Dew
Collectors to these Post-Conflict regions.

The Film La Montaña is about the conflict.
There will a free-will collection for Bibles for
distribution in remote areas of Colombia.
